DESCRIPTION

Anderson Ranch and the RISD Career Center partner to share the costs of the residency program for two graduating RISD students who are selected by Anderson Ranch for either a 10-week residency Fall 2022 (October to December) or a 5-week residency Spring 2023 (mid-March to mid-April). This will cover the costs of the residency - \$750 for 5 weeks or \$1,500 for 10 weeks - which includes housing, studio space, and meals. (Awardees are responsible for travel to/from the Ranch and the cost of their own materials.)

Anderson Ranch's Artists-in-Residence Program fosters creative and intellectual growth for emerging and established visual artists. Residents have access to world-class facilities at the Ranch and five weeks of uninterrupted studio time. Anderson Ranch provides studios, facilities, a community of working artists, and feedback from visiting artists and critics. The Ranch setting is specifically crafted to aid artists in the production of their work, free from the distractions of everyday life.

ELIGIBILITY

- This opportunity is available to undergraduate and graduate students graduating in June 2022.
- International students are eligible.
- You must first be selected by Anderson Ranch for the residency in order to be eligible for the funding.
- Residencies are offered to artists who work in one of the following media: ceramics, new media, photography, furniture design, woodworking, painting, drawing, printmaking, or sculpture.

APPLICATION PROCESS & COMPONENTS

- Apply to Anderson Ranch's Artist-In-Residence Program by their February deadline and meet the criteria of their application process.
- In your application to Anderson Ranch, note your RISD education.
- Applicants are responsible for the \$30 Anderson Ranch application fee.
- Financial need is a factor in selection.
